

Sarah Wilson Last Will & Testament

I Sarah Wilson of the county of the county and state aforesaid being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner to form following that is to say, First that my ex^r here in after named shall provide for body a decent burial suitable to the wishes to the wishes of my relations and friends and pay all my funeral expences together with my last debts howsoever and to whomsoever owing out of the money that may first come into his hands as a part or parcel of my Estate

I give and devise to my son John Wilson two stoves and washpots I give and devise to my Grand daughters Agnes Jane & Eliza Wilson all my clothes Bed and furniture all my cooking, utensils and crockeries & to be equally divided I give and devise unto my Grand daughter Jane Wilson my bonny bonny my side Saddle my chest & my bed I allow my horse & cart two equally divided between my Grand sons William Wilson & Hugh Wilson I give and devise unto my Grand son George Wilson the other two horses I give and devise unto my Grand daughters Agnes and Eliza my other cows I give and devise unto my Grand daughter Elizabeth Wilson my spinning wheel I allow my Grandson's contents to my Grand ^{daughter} daughter Mary Anne I allow my large Bible to my son John and lastly I do here by constitute and appoint my Trusty friend John Stuart my lawfull Executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last Will and testament,
