this my last Will and Testament
in the manner and form following
& hereby revoking all other and former
will by me made before to fore made
or done

Item 1st I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Mary Griffin, all of my house
tract, of land on which I now live
during her lifetime or widowhood
Also all of my house hold and kitchen
furniture & stock of every description
not otherwise disposed of, during
her lifetime or widowhood.

Item 2nd My Will is that my Daughter
Rebecca C Griffin shall have the
tract of land of fifty nine acres
in the Union tract in

State of North Carolina being of sound
disposing Mind and Memory & calling
to mind the mortality of Men and know-
ing that it is appointed for all men once
to die, do make, assign and declare
this my last Will and Testament
in the manner and forms following
& hereby revoking all other and former
will by me heretofore before made
or done.

I command I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Mary Griffin all of my house
tract of land on which I now live
during her lifetime or Widowhood
Also all of my house hold and Kitchen
furniture & stock of every description
not otherwise disposed of, during
her lifetime or Widowhood.

Third - My Will is that my Daughter
Rebecca G. Griffin shall have the
tract of land of fifty nine Acres
Known as the Austin tract including

Item 3rd My Will is that the remainder of the
 lands known as the Weston lands be
 equally divided between my three children
 namely Ashley Griffin, Martha Griffin &
 Rebekah Griffin.

Item 4th My Will is that my daughter Sarah Jane
 Love shall have five Dollars in Money.

Item 5th My will is that my son George Calvin
 Griffin shall have one horse bridle &
 Saddle worth One Pound & Twenty five
 Dollars, and that he shall also have all
 of the house tract of land above willed
 to my beloved wife Mary Griffin during
 her lifetime or widowhood unto my son
 George Calvin Griffin.

Item 6th My will is that all the perishable proper-
 ty above willed to my beloved wife Mary
 Griffin during her life time or widowhood
 shall then be equally divided between my
 four children (to wit) Ashley Griffin, Martha
