I William E McCain of the State and County above named do make this as my last will and testament I do bequeath and devise that all my property and effects be bequeathed as I direct in this will the effects as follows To my wife M. R. McCain I bequeath one piece of land the homestead at this time eighty four acres with all the appurtenances thereto One other tract of land containing Ninety five acres Joining the one above & both tracts Joining Thomas Starnes I & McCain & others on the waters of Cain Creek One negr woman named Kate and two Children One boy Ben. One girl named Rels my Saddle Horse Charley One milch Cow and four Dry Cattle also twenty one head of Hogs and their increase One Buggy and harness One three quarter wagon and gearing all my farming tools and house furniture such as she may want and such as my wife M. R. McCain may need and also about Four hundred Dollars in notes due me or thereabouts and I owe about Three Hundred Dollars or thereabouts I desire that these my notes be collected at any time and out of the proceeds pay all demands against me and the balance of
