

William Howard's Last Will and Testament

I William Howard of the County of Mecklenburg and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say I direct that my Executor herein after named shall provide for - my Body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and friends and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts soever and to whomsoever owing out of the money which may first come into his hands as part or parcel of my Estate else to rest as cause to be erected Suitable Tomb Stones over my grave and the grave of my Wife Elizabeth after her decease such as is Common.

Item I give and devise to my beloved Wife Elizabeth the Plantation on which I now live containing about Two hundred and twenty acres together with all my Household and Kitchen furniture and all my Negro property To wit - Sarah - Abby - Edmund - Sophia and Jacob and all of my Stock of every description as Horses Cows Hogs Sheep &c Together with all my corn and fodder Wheate Oats Hoppups and the Crop which may be growing at the time of my decease also my Horse wagon and gun and Carriage Black Smith Tools Cotton gin and Screw and Thresher and all my farming Tools of every description and team and if my Wife Elizabeth at my decease in her wisdom and discretion thinks she does not stand in need of the above Stock and

of every description and leave care of my Wife Elizabeth at my decease in her wisdom and discretion thinks she does best stand in neede all the above stocks and other loose property she may sell the same or so much therof as she may not stand in need of with the Equitacion of the Negroes, and take the proceeds of the same apply it to her own use and I appoint my Executor to attend to the above business for my wife and to collect all debts due me at my decease and pay the same over with the proceeds of the sale if any to her to have and to hold all the above named property and proceeds to her the said Elizabeth for and during the term of her naturall life, and at her death I do devise and appoint it to be divided among my children as follows Viz, -

Item I give and devise to my oldest Son Robert Gordon Howard the above Plantation to have and to hold in fee simple for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my youngest Daughter Ann Bell ^{Sarah} Wife of Samuels Fullwood the above named Negro girl, to have and to hold to her and her bodily Heirs for ever.

Item I give and devise unto my three grand Children - Harriet, Nancy and Moses Children of my beloved Son Samuels Blythe Howard five dollars before to be paid to them by my Executor within two years from the time of the death of my wife Elizabeth out of any money belonging to my Estate which comes together with the advancement made to my son Samuels their Father at his marriage of the Plantation on which his Widow now lives their mother will make them a fair and Equitable

Parties according to the Value of my present Estate to have and to
hold to them and each of them for ever

Item my will and desire is that all the residue of the property
after taking out the above devises above mentioned be sold at public
Sale in twelve months Credit and the debts collected that may be owing
to the Estate and the proceeds of Sale and debts to be equally divided
among my children viz Sarah wife of Alexander Bell - Ellen wife of John
Lawson - Robert Gordon Howard - Jane wife of Amas Stevens - Catharine
wife of Conrad Wolf - Betsy Slythe wife of John Fullwood William McLean
Dicky Howard and Ann Bell wife of Samuel Fullwood in equal
proportion share and share alike to them and every one of them their
heirs Executors administrators and assigns absolutely for ever

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend
and beloved Son Robert G. Howard my lawful Executor to all intents
and purposes to execute this my last will and Testaments according to
the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause
thereof. In witness whereof I the said William Howard do here un-
