State of North Carolina

Union County March the 9th 1863

In The name of God. Amen.

The last will and testament of William R Price made the day and date above mentioned as follows.

First My will and desire is that all my property both real and personal belong to and remain with my wife Eliza C Price during her widowhood for the purpose of rearing and educating my children

Second. But in case my wife Eliza C Price marries then and in that case I desire my property to be divided equally between my children after paying all just demands & claims against the said estate.

Third I appoint my wife Eliza C Price executrix to this my last will and testament
