Imprimis I give and bequeath to my Daughter Lydia Lane One black Horse called Jack my Desk and looking Glass. Item I give to my Daughter Charity Green One feather Bed and furniture One Square Walnut Table and three flag Bottom Chairs. Item I give to my Son William Speights One large Black Walnut Chest and One Book Called the Explanation of the New Testament. Item I give to my Daughter Mary Myatt my Riding side Saddle. Item I give to my Daughter Patience Green One feather Bed and furniture One Roan Mare called Nance & One Iron Pott and all my puter ware. Item I give to Susana M^cGuffey One feather Bed and ~~furniture~~ two, two Year old Heffers Item I give to my Grandaughter Winnifred Hunter my Linnen Wheel. Item I give to my Grandaughter Winnifred Turner One Young Roan Mare two Years Old next Spring. Item I give and bequeath all the rest and remainder of my Estate of What Nature of kind soever not herein already Bequeathed to be Equally Divided amongst all my Children, and I do hereby Nominate and Appoint my Son William Speights & James Lane Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby Revoking and disannulling all former & other Will or Wills by me made ratifying this & only this to be my last Will and Testament. Last Will and Testament of Nathaniel Kimbrough dec.^d

In the Name of God Amen, I Nathaniel Kimbrough of Wake County and State of North Carolina being Sick & Weak in Body but of Sound Mind and Memory make this my last Will and Testament making null and Void all other Will or Wills heretofore by me made and first and foremost I give and bequeath my Soul to God that first gave it to me and my Body to be Desently Enterd at the Discretion of my Executors and as to my Worldly Estate I give and Bequeath in manner & form following (Viz.)

Item I give and bequeath to my Loving Wife Mary One Negroe Man Named Davy One Negro Woman Named Jude One Negro Boy Named Stafford and One Negro Man Blacksmith Named Granville and One Set of Blacksmiths Tools and One third part of all my Household & Kitchen furniture one eighth part of all my Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hoggs, Sheep &c to her her Heirs and Assigns forever also the Use of the Land Plantation whereon I now live during her Natural life of Widowhood. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Warren One Negro Boy Named Ben One Negro Girl Named Darkess & all my right to a Negro Boy Named Sam One Horse Bridle and Saddle One feather Bed and furniture all which Negroes and things are already delivered and all that other part of my Estate now in her possession to her her Heirs & Assigns forever. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Moore One Negro Man Named Davy One Negro Girl Named Winney and all my right and Title to a Negro Boy Named Jessee One Horse, Bridle and Saddle One feather Bed and furniture all which Negroes and things is already delivered to her with all that other part of my Estate already in her possession to her her Heirs
