Last Will and Testament, of Andrew Collins, Decd.

In the Name of God Amen. I Andrew Collins being very sick, and weak of Body but of perfect Mind and Memory, thanks be given to God for the same do call to mind the Mortality of my Body, knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to Die do Give and Bequeath of all my Worldly Goods in the following manner and of my Body to be Buried in a Decent Christian Manner, as my Executors shall see fit: Item, I Give to my Beloved Wife Martha Collins a Negro Fellow named Skipper Horse or Mare, to have her Choice, one Bed and furniture, to have her Choice, to have her Choice, 5 Cows and Calves, to have her Choice and likewise to have the Management, that is to buy and Sell and Trade as She now does in my lifetime during her Natural Widowhood and if any of my Negroes should Misbehave to be hired out at my Wife's discretion. Item it is my Desire that my two Plantations one on each side the Creek shall become the property of my six youngest Children & Negroes each my Fire Arms, and ^{all} Still, and my other Moveables, except given by Name to any of the others, and likewise to be given to them in my Wife's discretion or at her Decease, if any of
