Widowhood. I leave to my beloved Son Joel two hundred
and eighty Acres whereon I now live with the Plantation.
I leave to my beloved Daughter Lidia four hundred Acres
of Land lying on Bryor Creek and if my Wife is with
Child the land that

that my Daughter has and all the rest of my things to be divided between the two, and if my Wife is not with Child I desire that my Daughters land be made equal with my Sons Land with my things and the rest to be divided between the two this is my desire and my Will.
