
The Last Will & Testament of Edward Tucker Dec.^d -


In the Name of God Amen I Edward Tucker of the County of Wake in the province of North Carolina being very Weake and Sick of Body but of Sound and perfect Mind and Memory Thanks be to Almighty God for it and Calling to Mind the Certainty of Death and the Uncertainty of the time thereof do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and Form Following. Imprimas I give and Bequeathe to my Loving Wife Mary Tucker, my Stock of Horses, and five Cows and Calves next Spring and all my Household furniture & Plantation Tools. Item I give and Bequeathe to my Loving Wife the Survey of Land whereon I now live, that is not Deeded. Item I lend to my Loving Wife my Negro Girl Named Jude Dureing her Widowhood or till my Daughter Elizabeth Tucker Comes to Age or Marries. And my Desire is that the said Negro be Cept in the Said County of Wake untill my Said Daughter Comes to Age or Marries, as aforesaid. Item I give and Bequeathe to my Daughter Elizabeth Tucker that Parcell of Land that I bought of John M^oCullers Sheriff and also my Negro Girl Jude, when She comes to Age or Marries, and if my said Daughter Should Die without Lawfull Heir, in such Case my will and Desire is that

my aforesaid Wife shall have the aforesaid Land & Negro Legased to my Said Daughter. Item My Will and Desire is that my Executor & Executrix Sell the rest of my Estate that is not Legased and pay my Just Debts, & also Collect all my Debts due to me & the Money if any remaining to be laid out at the Discreession of my Executor in Purchaceing one Negro Girl for my aforesaid Daughter Elizabeth and if any Still Remaining that it be put to Intres for the yuse of my said Daughter Elizabeth. And lastly I appoint Joseph Lane and my Wife Mary Tucker Executor & Executrix of this my Last Will And Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand and Seal this 27th Day of November 1774.
