Item I lend to my Loving Wife my Negro Girl Named Jude Dureing her Widowhood or till my Daughter Elizabeth Tucker Comes to Age or Marries, And my Desire is that the said Negro be Cept in the Said County of Wake untill my Said Daughter Comes to Age or Marries, as aforesaid. Item I give and Bequeathe to my Daughter Elizabeth Tucker that Parcell of Land that I bought of John M.Cullers Sheriff and also my Negro Girl Jude, when She comes to Age or Marries, and if my said Daughter Should Die without Lawfull Heir, in such Case my will and Desire is the ake Co. 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Legased to my Said Daughter. Item My Will and Desire is that my Executor & Executrix Sell the rest of my Estate that is not Legased and pay my Just Debts. & also Collect all my Debts due to me & the Money if any remaining to be laid out at the Discression of my Executor in Purchaceing one Negro Girl for my aforesaid Daughter Elizabeth and if any Still Remaining that it be put to Intres for the yuse of my said Daughter Elizabeth.
