In witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Seventh day of Sept^r. 1778

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that Whereas the above bounden, Elizabeth Townly hath firmly & Voluntarily agreed to and with the said Henry Townly that for and in Consideration of a Beast and Saddle and a feather Bed and some

furniture, and a Bason and a Dish and Money to bear the said Elizabeth Townly's Expenses to her Sons in the South that she the said Elizabeth Townly doth relinquish any further pretences to any Dowry Whatsoever of the Estate of the late Thomas Townly Deceased therefore if the said Elizabeth Townly shall well and truly keep the agreement and be no further Chargeable to the said Henry Townly that then this Obligation to be Void & of no Effect otherwise to Stand and remain in full force and Virtue.
