Wake County ) THIS Indenture made this 7th day of March in the Year of Our Lord 1783 Between Joel Lane Esquire Chairman and Presiding Justice of our said Court in Behalf of himself as well as the Justices of the said Court of the One Part and Solomon Simmons of the other Part WITNESSETH that the said Joel Lane on behalf of himself as well as the rest of the Justices aforesaid hath Put out and bound James Oliver Apprentice to the said Solomon Simmons the said Solomon Simmons to Teach his said Apprentice in the Art, Mistery and Occupation of a Planter and further to Teach or Cause to be Instructed in Reading and Writing Agreeable to his Degree and Agreeable to Law, and the said James Oliver is to Serve his said Master well and faithfully untill he attains the Age of Twenty One Years being on or about the 8th day of March Instant of the Age of Eleven Years during which time the said Solomon Simmons shall provide and procure for his said Apprentice Sufficient
