Item Likewise I bequeath and do Give to my Daughter Winey Dunn one Negrou Gall by Name Silve and one bed and fernature Item I bequeath and do Give to my Daughter Betse Dunn One Negrou by Name of Adom and One feather bed and firnetur. Each of these my Children to Receave there posion at the age of Eighteen years. Item I do bequeath and do give to my Well beloved Wife Prudence Dunn One Negrou Gall by the name of Riner. Item I do bequeath the rest of my Estate in the Cear of My Executors to the surroort of my Children One Covering horse to be sold for the family use. I also so Consitute apoint and Ordain my Wife Prudence Dunn John Forde of Sussex County my Soule Exectrs of this my last Will and Testament and do hereby Revok disannul and make Void .all former Wills Testaments and requests declaring this and non other to be my Last Will Testement Seld with my Sele this Twenty Eighth Day October 1783

County and State of North Carolina being in a Low State
of Health but of perfect Sound mind and Memory and well
Knowing it is Appointed for all Men once to Die do make

wise Called Cullen Ballenger Son of my Said Wife Susannah
four Negroes (to wit) Ceaser Emily Harry & Fan Also one
half of my Land that lies on Macks Creek Containing Sev-
en Hundred Acres Also the other half I Give & Bequeath
to the Aforesaid W^m Luas to them there Heirs and Assigns
forever. I Give and Bequeath to Cary Lucas Called Cary
Ballenger Daughter of my Said Wife Susana, One Negro
Girl named Pat One Mare and Feather Bed and furneture.
Two Cows and Calves with the Increase of Said Negros &
Cattle to her her Heirs and Assigns forever. I give and
Bequeath to the Aforesaid W^m Lucas & Cullen Lucas Sons
of my Said Wife Susannah All the Remaindig part of my
Estate of every Nature and Kind
