This Indenture made the third Day of December in the Year of our Lord one thousand and Seven Hundred and Seventy One; Between Theophilus Hunter Esq. Chairman of our Inferior Court of the said County, and John Fox of the one part and Jacob Uttley of the other part, Witnesseth, That the said Theophilus Hunter on Behalf of the said Court hath put the said John Fox, Apprentice to the aforesaid Jacob Uttley, and to be taught in Reading and Writing Agreeable to Law and to serve Eight Years

from

from the Day of the Date of these presents, until He attains to the age of Twenty One being now Thirteen years old, and to serve Eight Years; During which time He shall behave himself as an honest and faithfull Apprentice ought to do; And the s.^d Jacob Uttley shall teach or cause to be taught his said Apprentice in the Art and Mistry of a Planter. And procure and provide for him sufficient, Meat, Drink, Washing and Lodging and appiral, fitting for such an Apprentice, during the said Term.

And further do and perform all other things mentioned in an Act of General Assembly of this Province. In Witness whereof, We have hereunto set our Hands and Seals, the Day and Year first above written.
