IN THE NAME OF GOD Amen I John Mays of Wake County
and Province of North Carolina being in a low State of
Health & Body but in perfect sence and Memory thanks be
to God for the same and knowing that is apointed once
for all men to die, doe make and Ordain this my last
Will and Testament in form and manner follows That is
to say after my decease for my Body to be Decently
Buried at the discretion of my Executors not doubting
but at the last day to receive the same again thro'
the mighty Power of God; And as for such Worldly Goods
wherewith it hath Pleased God to Bless me with do give
and Bequeath as follows VIZ that after all my Just
debts be paid I give and Bequeath to my Son James Mays
a Negroe Boy Named Antho and a Negroe Girl Named Ra-

then to be equally (the Benefit) to be Divided among
