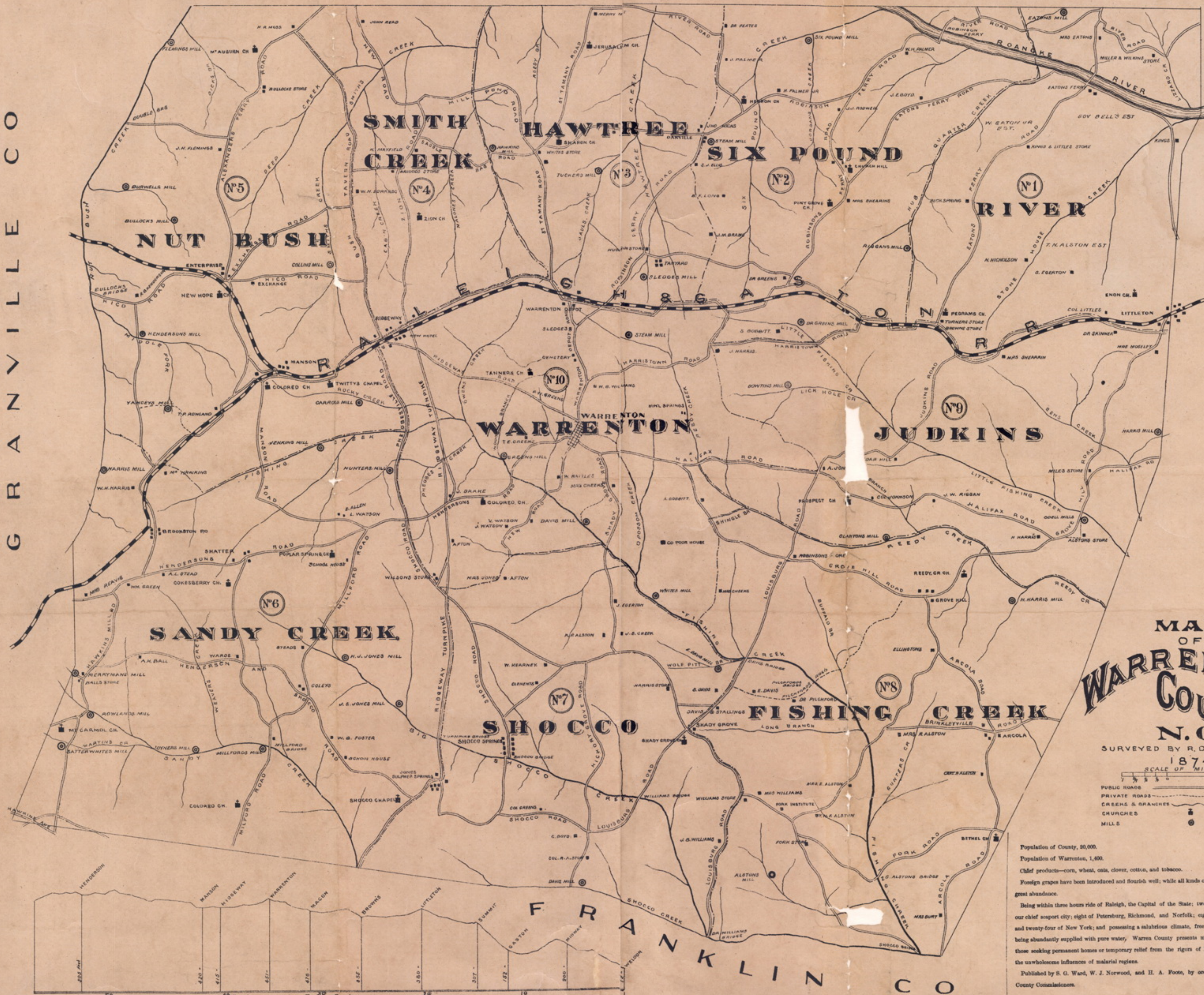

Being within three hours ride of Raleigh, the Capital of the State; twelve of Wilmington, our chief seaport city; eight of Petersburg, Richmond, and Norfolk; eighteen of Baltimore, and twenty-four of New York; and possessing a salubrious climate, free from malaria, and being abundantly supplied with pure water, Warren County presents many inducements to those seeking permanent homes or temporary relief from the rigors of Northern winters or the unwholesome influences of malarial regions.
