In the Name of God Amen I John Hall of South-  
Buncombe County do make this my last Will and Testament.

I give my Negro woman Nancy and her to my wife Mary Hall  
during her life or widowhood and all my inestimable Estate during her  
life or widowhood.

Now I give my daughter Lucy West my Negro woman Nancy and one Bed  
and furniture to her and her heirs and to have a sum a hundred pounds in  
my estate till her mother's death unless she should marry.

Item I give my daughter Sarah Hood my Negro boy Job after my wife's death to her  
and her heirs for ever.

Item I give my daughter Esther Washington one Bed and Furniture after her  
mother's death and the best child that my Negro woman may have I give  
unto Lucy Washington and her heirs.

There after my wife Mary Hall's death the Negroes paid her what is left  
to be equally divided between my two daughters and their heirs.

I appoint my wife Mary Hall and Birrer Hood my executors this the 27 day  
of July 1760 as Trustees my heirs and family day & date above written.

Thomas: In the Name of God Amen I Nathan Thomas of  
Will Bunco County in the Province of North Carolina being here laid  
abundant misery and goodness of God the weak in body yet of a  
sound and perfect understanding and memory do constitute this  
my last Will and Testament and desire it may be received as such  
by all. Impenitent I most humbly beseeche my soul to God my maker  
accepting his most acceptance of it. Impenitent I give my Body to his  
Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection  
from thence at the last day as for my Burial I desire it may be given  
as soon as the discretion of my executors hereafter named will have it well performed.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Nathan Thomas to him and  
his heirs for ever one Negro which I call Little and her increase  
and after also one Negro boy named Harry to him and his heirs  
forever.

Item I give to my Daughter Agnes her daughter hirs for ever one Negro boy him.

Item I give to my Daughter Sarah Winston our Negro girl Dier to her and hirs for ever with her husband.

Item I give to my Son John Giles Thomas to him and his hirs for ever one Negro boy named Tom.

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Nathan Thomas and his hirs for ever with all his Inwards & Rents after our said girl named Bess.

Item I give my Son Nathan Thomas all my Hogs to him and his hirs for ever.

Item I give Bequests and Disposals of the rest and residue of my Estate such as consists of only unusefull old Ware Mass Furniture bed and furniture to be equally divided between my children now alive & all the rest and residue of my Estate in North Carolina I give to my Son Nathan Thomas & his hirs for ever and to my Son John Giles Thomas & his hirs for ever and to my Son Nathan Thomas & his hirs for ever and to my Son Nathan Thomas Executor of this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this first day of January in the year of our Lord 1766.
