I have & do by these presents grant bargain sell & deliver unto the said Samuel
Temple one Negro boy called on name of Tom to hold to the said Samuel Temple
his heirs Ex^rs Adm^rs & Assigns to his & their only proper use & behoof for ever
and I the said Henry Temple the said Negro boy Tom unto the said Samuel
Temple his heirs Ex^rs Adm^rs & Assigns forever shall & will warrant & for ever
defend against me my heirs Ex^rs Adm^rs & all other persons whatsoever In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this first day of June 1765
