Credits of the deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession
knowledge or possession of the sd James Baskett or into the hands or poss^{on}
of any other person or persons for him & the same so made do exhibit or cause
to be exhibited into the Secretarys Office & are attested Copy thereof to the County
Court where the said Administration passed within ninety days after the
Date of these presents & the same Goods Chattels & Credits & all other the Goods
Chattels & Credits of the deceased at the time of his death which at any time
hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the sd James Baskett or
into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him do well &
truly Administer according to law and further do make or cause to be made
