Anne Dobbs Esq^r Governor of North Carolina in the full sum of seven hundred
and twenty pounds Sterling money to be paid to her & Arthur Dobbs his Successors
or Assigns to her which payment will & truly to be made we bind our
selves & every of us our & every of our heirs & Exec^r & Adm^r Jointly &
severally firmly by these presents sealed & dated 21st Nov^r A.D. 1764

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above named
James Baskett Administrator of all & singular his Goods, & Chattels Right
of William Baskett late of Bute County deceased do make or cause to be made
a true & just Inventory of all & singular his Goods & Chattels Rights &
Credits of his deceased which have or shall come to his hands possession
knowledge or possession of the said James Baskett or into those of his exec^r or adm^r
of any other person or persons for him & his same so made to exhibit a copy
to be exhibited into the Secretary Office & our attested copy being of the County
Court whereof Orders for administration passed within ninety days after the
Date of these presents & the same Goods Chattels & Credits & all other his Goods
Chattels & Credits of his deceased at the time of his death which at any time
hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said James Baskett or
into the hands in possession of any other person or persons for him do make
truly administrator according to law and further do make or cause to be made
a true & just Account of his Administration within one year after the Date of
these presents & all the rest & residue of his Goods, Chattels & Credits which

shall be found remaining upon the 3d Audit Acct. the same being first examined & allowed by the Governor & Council Superior Court or County Court shall recover & pay unto such person or persons respectively as the same shall be due pursuant to his audit & accounting of the Act in that case made provided and if it shall appear that any Will & Testament was made by the deceased & the Test. or Prob. has been named to exhibit his same into Court making request to have it allowed & approved accordingly if the P. James Basket being Testaments required to be under & before the 3d Letters of Administration approval of such Testament being first had & made in the 3d Court then his obligation to be paid, also to remain in force.
