In the name of God Amen I John Hall of South:
ampton County do make this my last Will and Testament.
I leave I leave my Negro woman Honor and her to my wife Mary Hall
during her life or widowhood and all my moveable estate during her
life or widowhood.
I leave I give my daughter Lucy West my Negro woman Honor and one bed
and furniture to her and her heirs and to have a linen a lowed bed in
my estate till her mother's death unless she should marry.
I leave I give my daughter Hannah West my Negro boy Joe after my wife's death to her
and her heirs for ever.
I leave I give my daughter Esther Washington one bed and furniture after her
mother's death and the best child that my Negro woman may have I give
unto Lucas Washington and her heirs.
Then after my wife Mary Hall's death the Negro's paid there what is left
to be equally divided between my three daughters and their heirs.
I appoint my wife Mary Hall and her executor this the 27 day
of July 1760 as witness my hand and seal y^e day & date above written.

Kane County in the Province of North Carolina being thro' the
abundant mercy and goodness of God thro' weak in body yet of a
sound and perfect understanding and memory do constitute this
my last Will and Testament and desire that may be received as such
by all. In witness I most humbly bequeath my soul to God my maker
bequeathing his most acceptances of it. In witness I give my body to his
earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection
from the same at his last day as for my Burial I desire it may be decent
done at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named who shall
will have it well performed.
I leave I give and bequeath to my son Nathan Thomas to him and
his heirs for ever one Negro woman named Lett and her increase
hereafter also one Negro boy named Barry to him and his heirs
for ever.
