Charles Knowallmen by these presents that I Henry Chaublis of the County of North in the Province of North Carolina for in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds good money of Virginia to us in hand paid by Benjamin Person of the County & Province aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby grant bargain sell and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Benjamin Person our certain Negro Slave named Robin to him his heirs and Assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Person his heirs and Assigns for ever and the said Henry Chaublis for himself his heirs &c. do hereby covenant agree to and with the said Benjamin Person that he the said Henry Chaublis will never sue and for ever defend the property of the said Robin to the said Benjamin Person his heirs & Assigns In Witness whereof the said Henry Chaublis hath hereunto set his hand and seal the 29th day of December A.D. 1762.
