Esq. Governor of the North Carolina in the first & full sum of four thousand
pounds paid to be paid to the said William Tryon his Successors or Assigns to
the which payment well & truly to be made us being our selves & every of us
jointly & severally for & in the whole by these presents. Sealed & dated
the 29 day of July A.D. 1766.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Sarah
Johnson & Charles Eaton do or shall do or cause to be made or
of Charles Eaton late of Butts County do or shall do or cause to be made or
have or possess Inventory of all singular the goods & Chattels Rights & Credits
of the deceased which have or shall come to the hands knowledges or possession
of the said Sarah Johnson or into the hands or possession of any other person or
persons or for the same do or shall do or cause to be exhibited into

for Administration of the said Estate within 12 Months after the Date of these presents and
 the same goods Chattels & Debts & all other the said Estate & Credits of the said
 at the End of this Space which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or
 possession of the said Sarah Johnson in the hands or possession of any other person
 persons for her or well & truly Administer according to law and further to wards or
 cause to be made a true & just Account of her said Administration within one year after
 the date of these presents and all the rest & effect of the said Goods Chattels & Debts
 which shall be found & remaining upon the said Admin. Account, the same being first
 examined & allowed by the Governor & Council General Just or County Court, shall
 deliver & pay unto such person or persons respectively as the said Court shall be duly
 pursuant to the true intent & meaning of the Act in that behalf made & provided, and if it
 shall appear that any Will or Testament was made by the said Deceased, and the Executor
 or Executors therein named do exhibit the same but not making it known to have
 it allowed & approved of accordingly, if the said Sarah Johnson above mentioned being
 thereunto required do render to the said Court of Administration, approbation
 of such Testament being first & made in the said Court then this Obligation to be
 void & to remain in force.
