Mat<sup>r</sup> Wills July 29<sup>th</sup> 1766 all men by these presents that we Robert Alexander Benjamin above Bonded Person & Robert Turnbull & Co<sup>t</sup> & firmly bound unto his Excellency William Tryon Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor & C<sup>r</sup> of North Carolina in the sum of Two hundred Pounds money to be paid to that S<sup>r</sup> William Tryon his Successors or Assigns to the which payment we will & truly to be made & not bind our selves & every of us jointly & severally for & in the whole our Heirs, Executors, Administrators & every of them by these presents sealed & delivered the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of July A.D. 1766.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Robert Alexander Admin<sup>r</sup> of all & singular his Goods, Chattels Rights Credits or Mathew Wills Decd. Bonds or cause to be made at his perfect Inventory of all singular his Goods, Chattels Rights & Credits of his Decease & his estate or shall come into hands, knowledged or possession of his Robert Alexander or into his hands or possession of any other person or persons for him & his uses so much as exhibit or cause to be exhibited into his Secretarys Office now allotted copy hereof to the County Court where Orders passed for Admin<sup>r</sup> within Ninety Days after his date of the 29<sup>th</sup> instant of his same Goods, Chattels & Credits & all other his Goods, Chattels Credits of his Decd. at the time of his death which at any time hereafter shall come into his hands or possession of his said Robert Alexander or in his hands or possession of any other person or persons for him to well & truly Admin<sup>r</sup> according to law & further to make or cause to be made a just Acc<sup>t</sup> of this his Admin<sup>r</sup> within one year after his date of his present, and all the rest & residue of his Goods, Chattels & Credits which shall

beforewards issuing upon his Agent. And the same being first examined and allowed by his Agent, the Superior or County Court shall deliver a copy unto such person or persons respectively as he and shall be and pursuant to the first intent and meaning of this Act in that case made provided and if it shall appear that any will or testament was made by his Agent or his Let. or Esq. before named do or did exhibit his same unto Court making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if his S<sup>t</sup> Robert Alexander being then unto required to render & deliver his letters of Agm<sup>t</sup>. approbation of such testament being first laid open in the Court there lies obligation to be void else to remain in force.
