 with one Slave named Juda and to my reputed daughter Ann the wife of William Martin
 I have given and proceot her with one Slave named Hanner & her increase
 for during the term of her natural life and from & immediately after her decease
 I give the said Slave Hanner & her increase to be equally divided among all
 such children as the said Ann shall have living at her decease that was born
 of her body, and to my reputed daughter Agnes the wife of Robert Martin
 I have given and proceot her with one Slave named Sam & her increase for
 during the term of her natural life and from & immediately after her decease I
 give the said Slave Sam & her increase to be equally divided among all such children
 as the said Agnes shall have living at her decease that was born of her body.

This Indenture made this twenty second day of September in
 the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty three between
 Daniel Osbald of the County of Granville & Province of the Carolina of this
 one part and John Brown of the County & Province aforesaid the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Daniel Osbald in Consideration of the sum of
 one hundred & eighty pounds unto him after expressed & contained in the said
 the said John Brown all that piece or tract of land called the Wood situated
 & lying in Granville County aforesaid containing Sixteen hundred fifty Acres
 with all appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold the said
 land premises to the said John Brown his Executors Assigns & his heirs from
 after the day of the date of these presents for and during the term of five or
 years yielding and paying herefor to the said Daniel Osbald his Executors
 the sum of five shillings & six pence yearly upon the first day of January

and if the said sum of twenty shillings or any part thereof shall be behind and
unpaid at the day and time above mentioned then it shall be lawful for the said
Daniel Ochs at his heirs or assigns to distrain for the same and the said John
Brown for himself his heirs assigns doth Covenant & Agree with
the said Daniel Ochs his heirs assigns well and truly to pay the said sum
above reserved on the said day limited and appointed for payment thereof In
Witness whereof the said Daniel Ochs hath hereunto set his hand & seal
the day and year first above written.

fore have bargained & sold and by these presents do fully & absolutely
bargain and sell unto the said Mary Nicholson his heirs & assigns
in plain open Market according to Law one Cow of David Hollomans
marked with Crop a slit & which side or y^e left ear & one
Cow marked with a slit in ones ear & five young or marked Cattle & one
Doath & one furniture one sheep one Fryng pan one Horse called
called Jane & one drum & one Saw marked of late with mark with
raight legs & saw on shot & marked with a Crop & slit in the right ear
& a Nick in the left ear a half Crop in the left ear and all my part of the Crop
of Corn & Tobacco that is now in the care of Messrs. Brown & Thomas Jedd
& bind up & parcel of them and all the Remainder of my household goods
calling debts now due to have and to hold the above bargained & sold
with the other goods and Chattels above mentioned unto the said Mary
Nicholson his heirs & assigns forever as his & theirs own proper
goods & Chattels to live & their heirs & assigns forever and I the aforesaid
Nicholson Junr my heirs & assigns & every of us with of this aforesaid
bargained & sold goods & Chattels are out and deforc unto y^e said Mary
