Know all men by these presents that I Henry Chamblis of the County of Duto in the Province of North Carolina for in consideration of the Sum of fifty pounds Curr^t money of Virginia to us in hand paid by Benjamin Person of the County & Province afores^d the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Benjamin Person our certain Negro man whose name is Robin to him his heirs and Assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Person his heirs and Assigns for ever and the said Henry Chamblis for himself his heirs Ex^{ors} & Ad^{ors} both co-suant & ag^{ts} to and with the said Benjamin Person that he the said Henry Chamblis will warrant and for ever defend the property of the said Negro to the said Benjamin Person his heirs & Assigns In Witness whereof the said Henry Chamblis hath hereunto set his hand & Seal the 29th day of December A.D. 1762.
