In the name of God Amen I John Edwards^{sr} of Swain County in the Province of North Carolina being weak of Body but of sound disposing memory thank be to God but calling to mind the frailty of nature and the mortality of the body that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & publish this my last Will and Testament in writing hereby revoking and annulling all other former Will or Wills by me heretofore made and publishing & declaring this as my last Will & Testament hereby first I give and bequeath my Soul to God Almighty the giver in full & true hopes of the glorious resurrection thro' the merits of Christ Jesus my only Saviour & Redeemer and my body to the Earth from whence it came to be decently buried according to the directions of my Ex^o last after name of

Imp. I Order and my will is that all my just Debts and funeral expenses be first paid out of my personal Estate.

 Tomple one Negro boy called or named Tom to hold to the said Samuel Tomple
 his heirs Ex^rs Adm^rs & Assigns to live & their only property & school for ever
 and I the said Henry Tomple the said Negro boy Tom unto the said Samuel
 Tomple his heirs Ex^rs Adm^rs & Assigns for ever shall & will warrant & for ever
 defend against me my heirs Ex^rs Adm^rs & all other persons whatsoever In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this first day of June 1765
