Negroes & their increase if any be divided among the said Mary Sarah &
John when the youngest of the said children that shall be alive arrive to the age
of twenty years and if any of them decease without issue or under the

the doct^rs and for the confirmation of the said gift the said Mary hath
brought to set her hand and fixed her seal the sixteenth day of July in the
year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and sixty five.
