

Know all men by these presents that we Elizabeth Fuller of North Carolina in the just full sum of Two hundred pounds good money to be paid to the said William Tryon his Successors or Assigns to the which payment well truly to be made we bind ourselves every of us jointly & severally for in the whole our heirs Exors & Adms. every of them by these presents sealed & dated the 2nd day of January Anno Domini 1707.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Elizabeth Fuller Administratrix of all & singular the goods & Chattels Rights & Credits of Timothy Fuller late of the County of Butts deceased do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all & singular the goods & Chattels of the deceased which have or shall come to the hands knowledge or possession of the said Elizabeth Fuller or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her and her same do make do exhibit or cause to be exhibited unto the Society any Officer or attested copy thereof to the County Court where Orders for Administration passed within ninety days after the date of these presents and the same goods Chattels & Credits & all other the goods Chattels & Credits of the deceased at the time of his death which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said Elizabeth Fuller or into the hands or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her do well truly administer according to Law & further do make or cause to be made a true & just Acc^t of her Admin^{ist}ration within one year after the date of these presents and all the rest & residue of the said goods Chattels & Credits which shall be found remaining on the said Acc^t the same being first Examined & allowed by the Governor & Council Superior or County Court shall deliver & pay unto such person or persons respectively as the same shall be due pursuant to the true intent & meaning of the Act in that behalf made & provided and if it shall appear that any Will & Testament was made by the deceased & the said or Exors & Admin^{ist}rators do exhibit the same into Court making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if the said Elizabeth Fuller being thereunto required do send or the Letters of Admin^{ist}ration of such Testament being first had made in the said Court then this Obligation to be void Else to be & remain in force.
