stuff whatsoever of us the said John Golding Sen^r unto the said John Gold-
ing his Executors Administrators or Assigns from henceforth to his and
their own proper use and upon the said John Golding to do order & dispose
at their own proper use and pleasure as of their own proper
goods & chattels so & peaceably & quietly without any manner of
let or trouble or denial of us the said John Golding Sen^r or any other
person or persons whatsoever of all which premises I the said John
Golding Sen^r have put the said John Golding my son in full and peace-
able possession by virtue hereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
