The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Lucy Goodwin Administrator of all singular his Goods & Chattels Rights & Credits of Henry Goodwin deceased do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all singular his Goods & Chattels Rights & Credits of his Dec'd which have or shall come to his hands knowledge or possession of the said Lucy Goodwin or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her & the same so made to exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Secretary's Office & one attested copy thereof to the County Court where Orders for Administration passed within twenty days after the date of these presents & the same Goods & Chattels & Credits & all other his Goods & Chattels & Credits of his Dec'd at the time of his death which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said Lucy Goodwin or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her to well & truly Administer according to Law and further do make or cause to be made a just & true Account of his S<sup>t</sup> Account within one year after the date of these presents and all the rest & residue of his said Goods & Chattels & Credits which shall be found remaining upon the S<sup>t</sup> Account his same being first examined & allowed by the Governor & Council General Court or County Court shall Oliver & pay unto such person or persons as respectively as the same shall be due pursuant to the true intent & meaning of the Act in that case made & provided and if it shall appear to the County Court and Testamenter was made by his S<sup>t</sup> Dec'd & his Executor or Executrix therein named do exhibit the same into court making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if the S<sup>t</sup> Lucy Goodwin being thereunto required to make & deliver the Letters of Adm<sup>r</sup> approbation of such Testament being first read & made in the Court Room of
