Know all men by these presents that we Lucy Goodwin Theophilus Goodwin Theophilus Goodwin Jun<sup>r</sup>. & Peter Kimball are hold<sup>r</sup> firmly bound unto His Hon<sup>ble</sup> William Tryon Esq<sup>r</sup> Lieut<sup>g</sup> Governor &c of North Carolina in the Sum of Two hundred pounds procla<sup>m</sup> money to be paid to the said William Tryon his successors or assigns to the which payment well & truly to be made we bind our selves every of us our heirs &c Lucy Goodwin & Acqu<sup>t</sup> jointly & severally firmly by these presents sealed & dated this XXIX<sup>th</sup> day of October 1765.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Lucy Goodwin Administratrix of all & singular the Goods Chattels Rights & Credits of Henry Goodwin dec<sup>d</sup> do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all & singular the Goods Chattels Rights & Credits of the dec<sup>d</sup> which have or shall come to the hands knowledge or possession of the said Lucy Goodwin or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her & the same do make or cause to be exhibited into the Secretarys Office & one attested copy thereof to the County Court where Orders for Administration passed within ninety days after the date of these presents & the same Goods Chattels & Credits & all other the Goods Chattels & Credits of the dec<sup>d</sup> at the time time of his death which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said Lucy Goodwin or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her do well & truly Administer according to Law and further do make or cause to be made a just & true account of her & Acqu<sup>t</sup> within one year & for the date of these presents and all the rest & residues of the said Goods Chattels & Credits which shall be found remaining upon the p<sup>r</sup> Acqu<sup>t</sup> Account the same being first examined & allowed by the Governor & Council General Court or County Court shall deliver & pay unto such person or persons as respectively as the same shall be due pursuant to the true intent & meaning of the Act in that case made & provided and if it shall appear that any Will and Testament was made by the said dec<sup>d</sup> & the Executor or Executors thereof named do exhibit the same into Court making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if the said Lucy Goodwin being thereunto required do refuse to do the said Executors of Acqu<sup>t</sup> approbation of such Testament being first made in the Court then &c
