In the name of God amen &c: I John Hall of South:

amp/on County do make this my last Will and Testament.
I leave my Negro woman Harior and 100 to my wife Mary Hall
during her life or widowhood and all my moveable Estate during her
life or widowhood.

I leave I give my daughter Lucy West my Negro woman Harior and one Bad
and furniture to her and her heirs and to have a linen a lowed her in
my Estate till her moathors death unless she should marry.

I leave I give my daughter Jean Wood my Negro boy 100 after my wifes death to her
and her heirs for ever.

I leave I give my daughter Esther Washington one Bad and furniture after her
moathors death and the best child that my Negro woman may have I give
unto Luce Washington and her heirs.

Then after my wife Mary Halls death the Legies paid there what is left
to be equally divided between my three daughters and their heirs.

I appoint my wife Mary Hall and Bismor Wood my Executors this the 27 day
of July 1760 as Witness my hands and Seal 4 day 2 date about Kilton.

my last Will and Testament and desire it may be received as such

beseeching his most acceptance of it. Inprimis I give my body to his
Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection
from thence at the last day as for my Burial I desire it may be Buryed
Decent at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named who I do not
will leave it well performed.

I leave I give and beseech to my son Nathan Thomas to him and
his heirs for ever one Negro woman named Let and her increase
and after also one Negro boy named Barry to him and his heirs
for ever.
