coming two days and of then this present Bill of Sale shall be void & of no  
effect But if defauit be made in the payment of the said vintly four poun-  
ds shillings & eleven pence in part or in the whole contrary to the  
manner aforesaid. That then it shall remaine & be in full force &  
virtue In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal  
this 24<sup>th</sup> Day October 1764.
