to my wife Elizabeth Smith during her Widowhood and in case she marries then my  
personal Estate to be equally divided betwixt my son John Smith Thomas Smith Malcom Smith  
except one Cow and half a Quire to my daughter Ann Smith.

Item The plantation I now live on a the rest of my Land I leave to my son Thomas  
Smith
