 jointly severally for in the whole amount of £ 27. 12. 0^r money of North Carolina
 Sealed & dated the 29th Day of July 1768.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if I do any bound to Joshua
 Ingram Admin^r of all or singular his goods & chattels & his credit of his^r
 Ingram late of Bullock County deceased do make or cause to be made ex parte his
 Inventory of all & singular his goods & chattels rights & credits of his^r deceased which
 have or shall come to the hands knowledge or possession of his^r Joshua Ingram
 or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him & the same
 so made to exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Surveyor's Office and
 attested copy thereof to the County Court where Orders for Admin^r passed within
 ninety days after the date of these presents & the same goods chattels & credits &
 all other his goods chattels & credits of his^r deceased at the time of his death which
 at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of his^r Joshua
 Ingram or in the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him
 to wholly bury & inter according to due & Christian manner or cause to be
 made a true & just account of his^r debts within one year after his date of

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Robert Alexander Admin^r of all & singular his Goods, Chattels Rights Credits or Mathew Wills Decd. Bonds or cause to be made at his perfect Inventory of all singular his Goods, Chattels Rights & Credits of his Decease & his estate or shall come into hands, knowledged or possession of his Robert Alexander or into his hands or possession of any other person or persons for him & his uses so much as exhibit or cause to be exhibited into his Secretarys Office now allotted copy hereof to the County Court where Orders passed for Admin^r within ninety days after his date of the 29th instant of his same Goods, Chattels & Credits & all other his Goods, Chattels Credits of his Decd. at the time of his death which at any time hereafter shall come into his hands or possession of his said Robert Alexander or in his hands or possession of any other person or persons for him to well & truly Admin^r according to law & further to make or cause to be made a just Acc^t of this his Admin^r within one year after his date of his present, and all the rest & residue of his Goods, Chattels & Credits which shall
