Know all men by these presents that I George Martin of the County of Providence aforesaid in consideration of the Sum of four hundred & eighty pounds eight shillings & six pence half penny piece money to us in hand paid by Philipson Hawkins of the same County & Province have bargained sold given over & delivered to the said Philipson Hawkins in plain open Market six Negro Slaves viz. Mabel, Bobb, Tom, punch, Jonaloe, Doll, Sarah & Beth And I the said Geo. Martin do for my self my heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> & Assigns further assign to & with the said Philipson Hawkins his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> or Assigns to Harriet & for ever defend the title of the aforesaid bargained premises to the said Philipson Hawkins his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> or Assigns against the claim or demand of me the said George Martin my heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> & Assigns against the claim or demand of any other person or persons whatsoever shall & will hereafter be defended by these presents of which bargained premises I the said George Martin have put the said Hawkins in full possession of by delivering him one shilling & three pence each in the name of the whole In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Dom. 1769.
