Males. Bobb Tomp punch, James Dolf Sarah & Beth And I the said Geo. Martin do for my self my heirs Ex^{ts} & Assigns further assign to & with the said Philipmon Hawkins his heirs Ex^{ts} or Assigns to Harriet & for ever defend the title of the aforesaid bargained promises to the said Philipmon Hawkins his heirs Ex^{ts} or Assigns against the claims or demand of me the said George Martin my heirs Ex^{ts} or Assigns against the claims demand of any other person or persons whatsoever shall & will hereafter be defended by these presents of which bargained promises I the said George Martin have put the said Hawkins in full possession of by delivering him one shilling & this price paid in the name of the whole In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 7th day of August Anno Dom. 1765.
