will & pleasures as of their own proper Negro free & peaceably & quietly without
any manner of Lett trouble or denial of us the said Robert Allen or any other person
persons what so ever and have put the said John Hudson & Elizabeth Hudson his
wife & their heirs in full & peaceable possession by virtue hereof in which
whereof the said Robert Allen have herunto given under my hand & seal
this nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred & sixty six.

of the Province in the full sum of eighty pounds procl. money to be paid
to the said William Tryon his Successors or Assigns to the which payment well
& truly to be made we bind ourselves & every of us jointly & severally for in
the whole our heirs executors & every of them by these presents sealed &
dated the 28. day of April Anno Domini. 1767.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas
Boll Agent of all singular the goods Chattels Rights & Credits of Robert McHounie
late of the County of Duto decd. do make or cause to be made a true & perfect
Inventory of all singular the goods Chattels Rights & Credits of the said decd.
which have or shall come to the hands know ledge or possession of the said
Thomas Boll or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him
& the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Secretarys
Office & one attested copy thereof to the County Court where Orders for Admin
paysd within nine days after the date of these presents & the same goods
Chattels & Credits & all other the goods Chattels & Credits of the said decd. at the time of
his death which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or posses
sion of the said Thomas Boll or into the hands or possession of any other person

or persons for him all truly Administer according to Law & further & make
 or cause to be made a true & just Acc^t of the said Acq^t within one year after the date of the for-
 feiture and all the rest & residue of the said goods Chattels & Credits which shall be found
 remaining on the said Acq^t the same being first Examined & allowed by the Governor
 & Council Superior Court or County Court shall deliver & pay unto such person or per-
 sons respectively as the same shall be due pursuant to the true intent & meaning of
 the Act in that case made & provided and if it shall appear that any Will & Testament
 was made by the Deced^t & that or let^r therein named do exhibit the same into Court
 making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if the said Thomas Bell being
 thereunto required do read & deliver the said Letter of Adminⁿ approbation of such
