provinces aforesaid. to them & their heirs forever one negro boy named Jack to live
& their own proper use & uses thereof & herewith to do order and at his or their
will & pleasures as of their own proper Negro free & peaceably & quietly without
any manner of lett trouble or denial of us the said Robert Allen or any other person
persons what so ever and have put the said John Hudson & Elizabeth Hudson his
wife & their heirs in full & peaceable possession by virtue hereof in witness
whereof the said Robert Allen have hereunto given under my hand & seal
this ninth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred & sixty six.

to the said William Tryon his Successors or Assignes to the which payment well
& truly to be made we bind ourselves every of us jointly & severally for in
the whole our heirs executors & every of them by these presents sealed &
dated the 28. day of April Anno Domini. 1767.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas
Boll Agent of all & singular the goods Chattels Rights & Credits of Robert McHounie
late of the County of Dutch deceased. do make or cause to be made a true & perfect
Inventory of all & singular the goods Chattels Rights & Credits of the said
which have or shall come to the hands know ledge or possession of the said
Thomas Boll or into the hands or possession of any other person persons herein
& the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Secretarys
Office & one attested copy thereof to the County Court where Orders for Admin
pation passed within nine days after the date of these presents & the same goods
Chattels & Credits & all other the goods Chattels Credits of the said
at the time of
his death which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or posses
sion of the said Thomas Boll or into the hands or possession of any other person

or persons for him... all truly Administ^r according to Law & further as made
 or cause to be made a true & just Acc^t of the said Adm^r within one year after the date of these
 precepts and all the rest proceeds of the said goods Chattels & Credits which shall be found
 remaining on the said Adm^r Acc^t. the same being first Examined & allowed by the Lord
 & Council Superior Court or County Court shall deliver & pay unto such person or per-
 sons respectively as the same shall be due pursuant to the true intent & meaning of
 the Act in that case made & provided and if it shall appear that any Will & Testament
 was made by the Deced^t or testator or testatrix therein named do exhibit the same into Court
 making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if the said Thomas Bell bring
 the same into request do read & deliver the said Will or Wills of Admin^r approbation of such
 Testament being first had & made in the said Court Thus this Obligation to be void else
 to be & remain in force.
