 and Testament wholly disannulling all former Wills heretofore by me made In  
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this third  
 day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred sixty & four

 Moore late of Dale County deceased. do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory  
 of all & singular the Goods & Chattels Rights & Credits of the deceased which have

or shall come to the hands knowledge or possession of the said Elisabeth  
 Moore or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her  
 and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Court  
 of the said Office and one attested Copy thereof to the County Court where Orders  
 for Administration passed within thirty days after the date of these pre-  
 sents and the same goods Chattels & Credits and all other the goods Chattels  
 & Credits of the deceased at the time of his death which at any time hereafter  
 shall come into the hands or possession of the said Elisabeth Moore or  
 into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her do well &  
 truly Administer according to Law and further do make or cause to be made a  
 true & just Account of her Administration within one year after the date of  
 these presents and all the rest & residue of the goods Chattels & Credits which  
 shall be found remaining upon the said Admin<sup>r</sup> Account, the same being first exami-  
 ned & allowed by the Governor & Council Superior Court & County Court shall deliver  
 & pay unto such person or persons respectively as the same shall be due pursuant  
 to the true intent & meaning of the Act in that behalf made & provided and if it shall  
 appear that any Will & Testament was made by the said deceased & the Exors  
 therein named do exhibit the same into Court making request to have it allowed  
 & approved of accordingly, if the said Elisabeth Moore being thereunto required do  
 refuse & deliver the said Letters of Administration, approval or of such Testament being
