unto the Orphan when & as soon as the Orphan shall attain to Lawful Age all mch Estate
or Estates as w^{ch} is or are or hereafter shall appear to be then due to him, or when the same
required by the Justices of the County Court as also keep & save unto the above named Justices
their & every of their heirs Ex^{ors} & Assigns of & from all trouble & damages that shall or may arise

Will and Testament in manner and form as follows

I Give and Bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Smith the Plantation I now live on
and all the Land I hold except one hundred Acres of the upper part of y^e place that
was formerly W^m Nobbs that I leave to my son John Smith and all my personal Estate to
my wife Elizabeth Smith during her Widowhood and in case she marries then my
personal Estate to be equally divided betw^{en} John Smith Thomas Smith Markes Smith
except one Cow and half I give to my daughter Ann Smith.

I Give the Plantation I now live on & the rest of my Land I leave to my son Thomas
Smith
