Virginia to me in hand paid by Benjamin Person of this County & Province above the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant Bargain sell unto the said Benjamin Person our certain Negro man slaves named Robin to him his heirs and Assigns to his only proper wife and beheld of him the said Benjamin Person his heirs and Assigns for ever and the said Henry Chambliss for himself his heirs &c. also doth covenant & agree to and with the said Benjamin Person that the said Henry Chambliss will warrant and for ever defend the property of the said Negro to the said Benjamin Person his heirs & Assigns In witness whereof the said Henry Chambliss hath hereunto set his hand & seal the 27th day of December A.D. 1763.
