In the name of God Amen I Borg Rush of Prince Wm County in the Colony of Virginia being in perfect health of sound mind and memory do give do hereby certify that on the day of October in the year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred & fifty nine make and give & publish this to be my last Will & Testament revoking all former and other Wills heretofore by me made acknowledging this and this only to be my last Will & Testament in manner & form following to wit, I do commend my soul to the hands of Almighty God who gave it me and my body to the earth from whence it came to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my ex<sup>or</sup> hereafter named.

I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Amey Rush the life benefit and occupation of all my personal estate which I desire she may enjoy during her natural life and after her decease I give & bequeath the same estate and the increase thereof to my loving son Borg Rush and his heirs for ever.

I now I give & bequeath to my loving son Borg Rush and to his heirs for ever five hundred & twenty acres of land it being part of a greater tract containing six hundred & forty acres of land situated lying & being in the County of Granville in North Carolina lying on both sides of Sandy Creek granted to me by Indenture bearing date the twentieth day of June in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred & forty nine relation being thereunto had may more fully at large appear and lastly I constitute and appoint my loving wife & my loving son Borg Rush to be my whole ex<sup>ors</sup> of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day month and year above written. My will is that my estate shall not be appraised.
