The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound John Fletcher Guardian of John Duke's Orphan of John Duke dec'd. shall well & truly pay & deliver unto the said Orphan when he the said Orphan shall attain to lawful Age, all such Estate or Estates as was is or are or hereafter shall appear to be then due to him, or when hereunto required by the Justices of the said County Court as also hereafter the above named Justices their exors of their heirs & assigns & from all such Damages that shall or may arise about the said
