The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Clanton
Guardian of Marcus Clanton Orphan of William Clanton deceased shall well & truly pay & deliver
unto the said Orphan whom as soon as he the said Orphan shall attain to lawful age all such Estates
or Estates as were in or are or shall after appear to be then due to him, or which he orents
required by the Justices of this County Court as also his expenses of his above named Justices
their pecuniary of their heirs & executors of & from all friendly damages that shall occur aribe
about the said Orphans Estate then this Obligation to be void, & to remain in force.

personal Estates to be equally divided between John Smith, Thomas Smith & Matthew Smith
excepting Cow and Calf I give to my daughter Anne Smith.

Item. The Plantation I now lie on a the rest of my land I leave to my son Thomas
Smith

under affor his Mother's death.

I do appoint my wife Elizabeth Smith and my son John Burkhardt of this my last Will and Testament making void all other Wills he testifies made by me and witness my hand & seal
the twenty third day of June 1763.

named Robin to him his heirs and Assigns to his only proper use and behoof of him the said
Benjamin Person his heirs and Assigns for ever and the said Henry Chambliss for himself
his heirs &c. doth covenant & agree to and with the said Benjamin Person that the
said Henry Chambliss will warrant and for ever defend the property of the said Negro to the
said Benjamin Person his heirs & Assigns In witness whereof the said Henry Chambliss hath
hereunto set his hand & seal the 27th day of December A.D. 1763.
