 County in the Province of North Carolina for and in consideration of the
 sum of Ten Pounds Sterling money to me in hand paid by Charles
 Johnston of the County & Province aforesd. His receipt whereof I do hereby
 acknowledge & have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do
 Grant Bargain & sell unto his son Charles Johnston two hundred pounds
 acres of land within the aforesd County on Pumpkin Branch whereon I now
 live & six head of cattle one horse branded himself on the near Buttock one black
 Mare unbranded three cows & pigs three leather beds & furniture half a dozen
 Chairs three Chests four Pewter Dishes half a dozen plates two iron pots
 one Frying pan with all other of my utensils of what kind soever to him
 his said Charles Johnston his heirs & assigns to have and to hold
