

Governor of North Carolina in the just & full sum of Two hundred pounds, paid money to be paid to the said William Tryon his Successor or Assigns to the which payment well & truly to be made & to be paid & every of us jointly & severally for & in the whole our heirs & assigns & every of them by these presents sealed and dated the 24th Day of July A.D. 1766.

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Elizabeth Young Administratrix of all singular the Goods & Chattels Rights & Credits of James Young late of North Carolina deceased do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all singular the Goods & Chattels Rights & Credits of the deceased which have or shall come to the hands know ledge or possession of the said Elizabeth Young or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her & the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Secretarys Office & cause attested Copy thereof to the County Court where Orders for Adminⁿ passed within ninety days after the date of these presents & the same Goods Chattels & Credits & all other the Goods Chattels & Credits of the deceased at the time of his death which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said Elizabeth Young or in the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her & well & truly Adminⁿ according to law and further do make & cause to be made a true & just Acc^t of her & Adminⁿ within one year after the date of these presents call the rest & residue of the said Goods Chattels & Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Acc^t the same being first examined & allowed by the Gov^r & Council General Court or County Court, shall deliver & pay unto such person or persons respectively as the same shall be due pursuant to the true intent & meaning of this Act in that case made & provided and if it shall appear that any Will & Testament was made by the deceased and the Ex^r or Ex^{rs} thereof named do exhibit the same into Court making request to have it allowed & approved of accordingly if the said Elizabeth Young being thereunto required do render & deliver the said Ex^{rs} of Adminⁿ approbation of such Testament being first had & made in the said Court Then this Obligation to be void Else to be & remain in force.
