And I do nominate & appoint my daughter Maggie sole Executrix of this my last Will & testament, hereby revoking & making void all previous Will or Wills be any time heretofore made by me & to declare this to be my last will & testament.

- I give devise and bequeath to my brother Ed Morris four head of cows out of my home stock and the remainder of my homes stock I give devise and bequeath to my brother S H Morris.
- I give devise and bequeath to my brother J H Morris my interest in the Old Homestead tract of land beginning at the run of "My Lady Hole" Swamp and extending to the Run of Horse Swamp known as the Devil Boys tract of land.
- I give devise and bequeath to my brother S H Morris my interest in the bay horse named "Dan".
- I give devise and bequeath to my two brothers jointly and equally J L Morris & J A Morris my stock of cattle that I bought from Ed Morris marked "Candy" & all the right and under square the left.
- I give devise and bequeath to my two brothers F L & J Morris jointly and equally my interest in the Dismal known as the Goodman or Begum & Corn Swamp with exception as provided in clause No 7 of this Instrument.
- I give devise and bequeath to Ed Morris S H Morris & Penelope E Pearce each One Dollar, same to be paid to them by J L Morris and J A Morris in cash as between Morris S H Morris and Penelope E Pearce interest in my portion of the land described in clause No 7 of this Instrument.
