half of said farm.

Fourth: My will and desire is for my two

piration of two years after they have come in
possession of said land pay over to my
daughters Octavia and Mattie Iowlin the
sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars
each. That is to say One Hundred and Fifty
Dollars to Octavia and One Hundred and
Fifty Dollars to Mattie Iowlin and the
same shall not bear any interest.

Fifth: I hereby constitute and appoint
my beloved wife Luritta Davis my lawful
executor to all intents and purposes to
execute this my last will and testament
according to the true intent and meaning
of the same.
